Enclosure (1) delegates to Commander, Naval Facilities Engineering Command the authority to issue appropriate termination for convenience notices and to commence settlement negotiations for all DON cable franchise agreements affected by base closure and realignment as directed by the Defense Base Closure and Realignment Act. This authority is hereby redelegated to Atlantic Division, Southern Division, EFA Southwest Division, and Pacific Division, with the authority to redelegate as required. However, all actions to be taken must first be coordinated with COMNAVFACENGCOM.
2. COMNAVFACENGCOM will take the lead in issuing the termination for convenience and conducting settlement negotiations for the cable television franchise agreement at Naval Complex, Adak, Alaska.

Subj: NATIONAL DEFENSE AUTHORIZATION ACT FOR FISCAL YEAR 1997
PUBLIC LAW 104-201

Section 833 of the subject law, entitled Cable Television Franchise Agreements, requires that an appropriate official of the Department of Defense promptly issue a written notice of termination for convenience of the Government and commence settlement negotiations for covered agreements pursuant to Part 49 of the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR). The cable franchise agreements are for the construction, installation, or capital improvement of cable television systems at military installations of the Department of Defense subject to closure under direction of the Defense Base Closure and Realignment Act, 10 U.S.C. 2687, note.

The Commander, Naval Facilities Engineering Command is hereby delegated the authority to issue appropriate termination for convenience notices and commence settlement negotiations for all Department of the Navy cable franchise agreements affected by base closure and realignment as directed by the Defense Base Closure and Realignment Act. This authority is redelegable within your Command.

The termination for convenience actions are to be issued pursuant to the authority of Section 833 of Public Law 104-201. By copy of this letter the Commanders, Naval Media Center and Naval Information Systems Management Command, are requested to provide such information or assistance as may be requested by Commander, Naval Facilities Engineering Command.

Financial issues related to execution of the terminations are to be coordinated with the Office of the Comptroller of the Navy.
